

## GENERAL CLUB RULES

1. Read all warning signs prior to entering the grounds or circuit.
2. Only members of the Collie Motorcycle Club are permitted use of the Stockton Park circuit or Hillman Farm track. Under no circumstances shall any person who is not a member ride on the circuit or within the club grounds.
3. Any person found permitting a non-member to ride a motorcycle on the club grounds will face disciplinary action.
4. Any person wishing to utilize any of the club facilities, (track or buildings), MUST contact the club caretaker to confirm the availability of these facilities. You must contact the caretaker once you enter the premises where you may be advised of any conditions or requirements in place at that time.
5. Any person present at Stockton Park and Hillman Farm shall abide by any reasonable request or direction given by the caretaker.
6. Any person who has authorized use of the facilities must pay any fee prescribed for such use. The amount of the fee may vary at the discretion of the CMCC.
7. Any person riding or practicing on the Stockton Park circuit or Hillman Farm track may only do so whilst a permit as issued by MWA is in place and MUST hold some form of license as issued by MWA. The minimum requirement is a Recreational License. Either annual or one day.
8. Any person riding or practicing on the Stockton circuit or at Hillman Farm track MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult person. (In case of accident) This person need not be a member of the Collie Motorcycle Club but must hold at least a Level 1 officials license and fulfill the requirements as an official for the rider/s that he / she is acting for. This includes ensuring the log book is completed for his / her party.
9. Any official present at the course while a permit is in place has a duty of care to ensure that any other official present is acting in accordance with the requirements of MWA & CMCC
10. Riding on the track shall be in the normal direction of racing (clockwise) and shall be during daylight hours only.
11. Entry to the circuit shall be from the start area and exit via the pit return lane.
12. Cutting across the circuit is dangerous and is forbidden.
13. No person is to tamper with the track watering system. Arrangement for track watering is to be made with the caretaker or club executive.
14. All protective riding equipment is to be worn while riding on the circuit. This includes – an approved helmet, goggles, gloves, long sleeved shirt or jumper, long pants and boots. Tear offs are not permitted at Hillman Farm track.
15. Riding of motorcycles is restricted to the circuit only. Motorcycles are not permitted to ride on any roadway or area outside the course.
16. The first lap of the course shall be conducted at a slow pace to enable the rider to evaluate the track conditions and any hazards that may exist. If any hazard exists, you are obliged to warn other riders of it. Ride to conditions at all times.
17. While riding on the course, equal time must be shared between different capacity classes or different skill levels of riders. Common sense is to prevail at all times.
18. The track or parts of the track may be closed from time to time. Were possible members will be advised by email or the CMCC website. Otherwise a track closed sign will be placed on the course.
19. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds. Guide dogs excepted.
20. Excepting during organized activities, the Main gates are to remain locked at all times.
